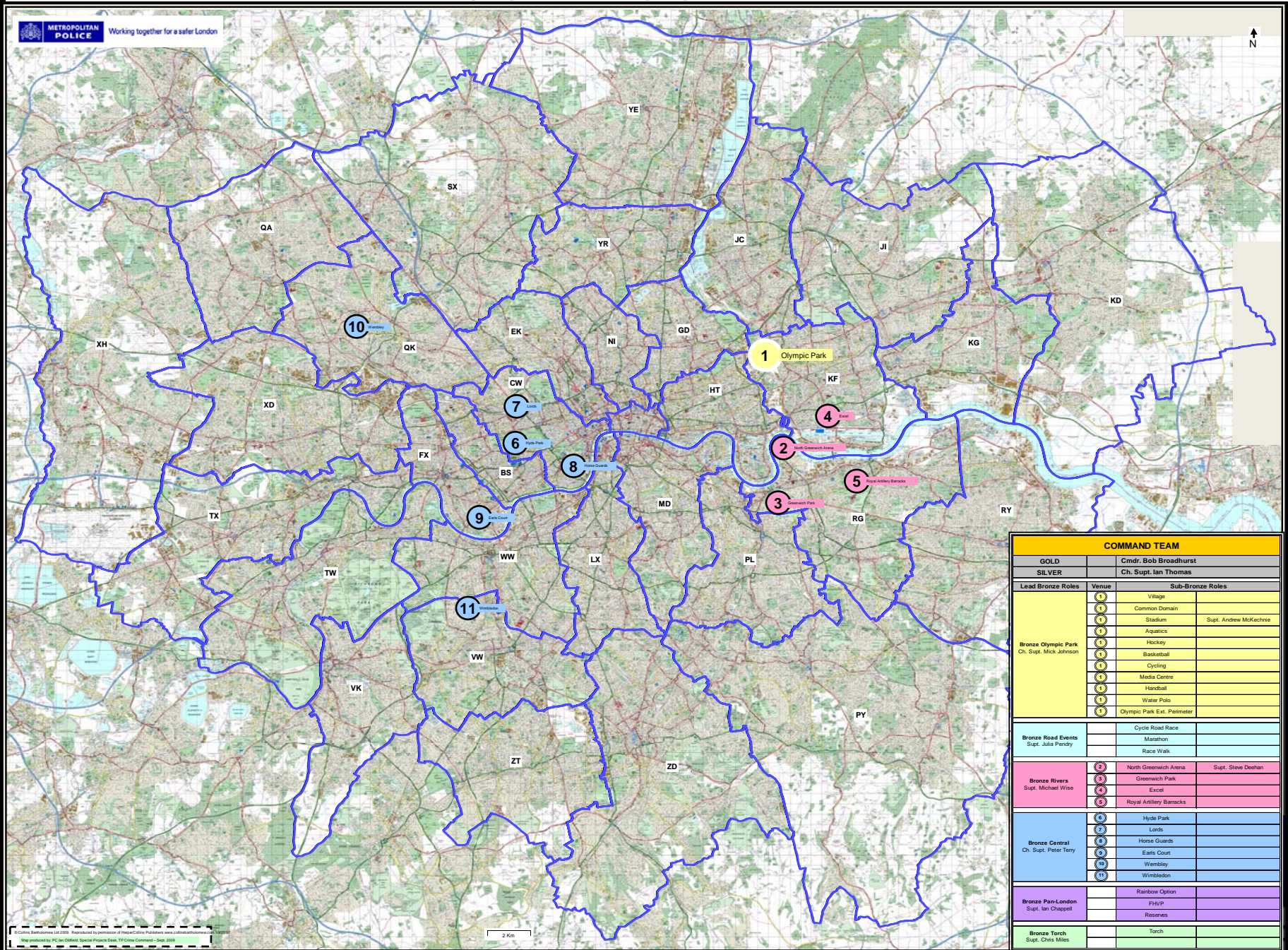
Olympic Difference
